

Ivy Wristers



These wristers are both beautiful and soft. The stitch pattern is easy to learn, and works up in a rectangle that is later seamed into a glove. Breathable and elegant, these wristers are sure to become a favorite in your accessory collection!

Materials Used:

I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook
1 skein of Caron Simply Soft in Dark Sage
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Abbreviations:

Chain (Ch)
Single Crochet (Sc)
Double Crochet (Dc)

Wristers:

Ch 29.

Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook, 1 dc into each of next 2 ch, ch 3, 1 dc into next ch, *skip 2 ch, 1 dc into each of next 3 ch, ch 3, 1 dc into next ch, rep from * to last 2 ch, skip 1 ch, dc into last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), *into next ch 3 space work (3 dc, ch 3, 1 dc), rep from * to last 3 dc, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into next ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, *into next ch 3 arch work (3 dc, ch 3, 1 dc), rep from * to last 4 dc, skip 3 dc, 1 dc into 3rd of 3 ch at beginning of previous row, turn.

Repeat Row 3 seven times, until you have 10 rows total. Fasten off, leaving 12 inch tail. Fold glove lengthwise and use tail to seam up the edges, leaving a 1 ½ inch gap for the thumb hole.

Weave in all ends.
